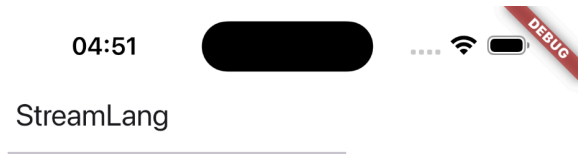
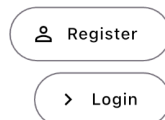


StreamLang User Manual



Logging In & Password Reset

- If you already have an account, tap **Login**, enter your email and password, and access your account.
- If you forget your password, tap **Forgot password?** on the login screen. Enter your email address and tap **Send Link** to receive instructions to reset your password.

Getting Started

To use StreamLang, you will need to register an account so the app can track your learning progress and save your listening configurations.

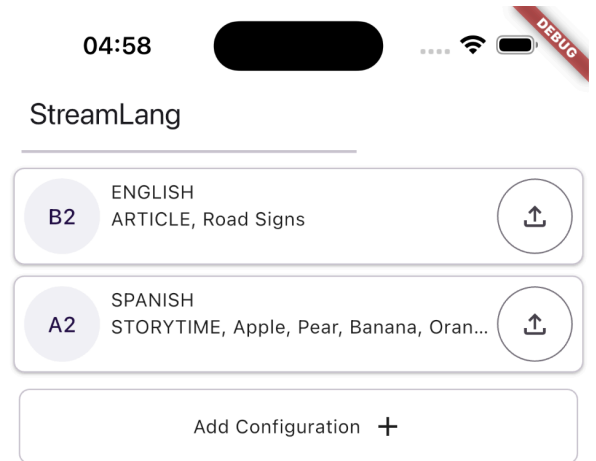
- Tap **Register** on the opening screen.
- Enter your name and email address.
- Create a strong password and confirm it.

The Home Screen & Templates

Once logged in, you will land on the Templates page. Here, you can access and manage listening stream configurations.

- **Start Listening:** Tap any existing configuration card (e.g., "German B1 - Goethe, Storytime") to immediately launch the audio player and start listening.
- **Resume:** The app remembers where you left off. If you tap a template you've listened to before, it will resume from your exact last position.
- **Share a Template:** Tap the share icon (an upward-pointing arrow) on a configuration card to copy a link to your clipboard. You can share this link to make your custom stream public.
- **Delete a Template:** Swipe a configuration card to the left to reveal a red delete button (a minus sign). Tap it to permanently remove

the template.



Creating a Custom Listening Stream

You can fully customize your comprehensible input. Tap **Add configuration** on the Templates page to build a new stream.

1. Language & Level

- Select your target language from the dropdown.
- Use the slider to set your CEFR proficiency level (e.g., A2, B1, C1).

2. Grammar Settings

- **Grammar Structures:** Tap the specific grammar concepts you want to practice (e.g., Past Tense, Dativ, Akkusativ, Plusquamperfekt).

3. Content Type

Select the format of the audio you want to hear:

- **Article:** Informational texts.
- **Storytime:** Narrative-driven content.
- **Sentences:** Individual, disconnected sentences focusing heavily on your target grammar/vocab.

4. Translation & Narrator Settings

- **Translation Mode:** Choose whether you want to hear translations. You can choose to hear translations after every sentence or at the end of the entire audio.
- **Narrator:** Select the voice you want to read the target language, and adjust the speaking speed using the slider.

- **Translation Voice:** If you enabled translations, select the narrator for your native language.

5. Vocabulary & Topics

- **Custom Topics:** Type specific themes (e.g., "Fruits and vegetables") or a comma-separated list of exact words you want included in the stream.
- When you are finished, tap **Next** or **Start Listening** to generate your stream.
